- May 15 After School depart Medicine Hat for Calgary (overnight Calgary)
- May 16 Morning Flight to Tampa, Florida. Board bus to Fort Myers – lunch on route. Check into Hotel. Dinner. Evening TBA
- May 17 Morning school performance Bonita Springs.
Afternoon Beach. Evening Workshop at Florida Gulf Coast University.
- May 18 Day trip to Miami Beach stopping in Alligator Alley on route where we will learn about the everglades and take an air boat ride.
- May 19 Beach or visit to the Edison & Ford Winter Estates. Noon hour performance. Afternoon drive to Orlando. Dinner. Evening to enjoy facilities at our Disney resort.
- May 20 All Day at Disney including a featured performance by CHHS
- May 21 All Day at Disney
