**RECOGNITION FOR MAJOR SECONDARY EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

**BACKGROUND**

Traditionally, the District has provided financial support towards a student extra-curricular program in each of the schools. Policy 515, Assigned Time for School-Based Professional Staff, provides for 200 minutes per week (125 hours per year) of non-instructional time for each teacher. In view of the fact that many teachers expend a great deal of extra time beyond Policy 515 on extra-curricular activities, the Board of Trustees intends to recognize those teachers who give extraordinary service.

**POLICY**

The Board of Trustees encourages all teachers to provide leadership and to make contributions to student development and education, outside regular classes, through participation in extra-curricular programs. Teachers who provide major contributions to the secondary extra-curricular program will receive financial recognition according to the policy guidelines.
